

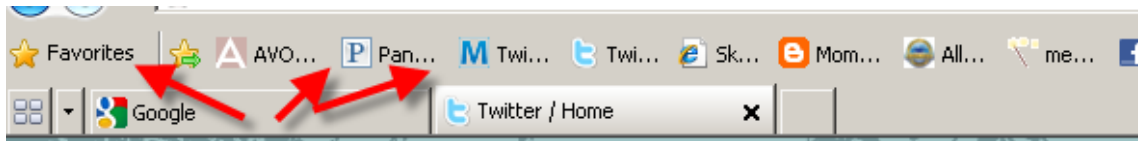
### Lesson 3, Favorites, Tabbed Browsing in IE8

IE8 also has a Favorites bar feature in addition to the Favorites tab to quickly access a frequently visited website. When on a favorite website/page, click the Favorites button and then click:



**Add to Favorites.**

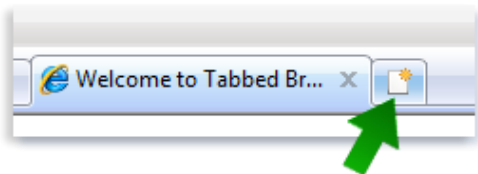
The website icons can be clicked and dragged to arrange order to your favorites.



### Tabbed Browsing

Tabbed browsing is a feature in Internet Explorer that allows you to open multiple websites in a single browser window. You can open web pages on new tabs, and switch between them by clicking the tab. If you have multiple tabs open, you can use **Quick Tabs** or **Tab List** to easily switch to other tabs. The advantage is that you have fewer items open on the taskbar.

To open a new blank tab, click the New Tab button on the tab row or press CTRL+T. To open a new tab when you follow a link on a web page, press CTRL as you click the link or right-click the link and then click Open in New Tab. If you have a mouse with a wheel, you can click a link with the wheel to open a new tab.



Click the X on the tab to close it. If you have a mouse with a wheel, you can click a link with the wheel to open a new tab.
